Since winning the Super Bowl in 2000 the Ravens have been nothing more than a middle-of-the-road team. In 2007 they only managed five wins with just three points spread covers to show for it. Brian Billick is out as head coach and has been replaced by John Harbaugh, who was the defensive backs coach with the Philadelphia Eagles last season. Harbaugh's first move was hiring Cam Cameron as his new offensive coordinator. QB Joe Flacco was the guy the Ravens wanted in the draft and he will break in behind Kyle Boller and Troy Smith until he's ready to start. RB Ray Rice is a great addition who will be able to contribute immediately and spell RB Willis McGahee. With a new coaching staff, new systems in place and building depth through the draft, the Ravens are on the right path. The 2008 edition of the Ravens should be an exciting club to watch but going up against the league's fourth-toughest schedule won't make it easy. One profitable stat from last season for totals bettors was a 9-5-2 O/U record, the best in the division. With Steve McNair retiring, the reins will be passed to whoever wins the competition between Kyle Boller and Troy Smith. Boller has had his chance to shine, and has failed on more than one occasion. Troy Smith should get his opportunity at some point this year to try and lead this team into the future. The Ravens could be a surprise team this season if they can stay healthy, and even compete for a .500 record in the tough AFC North division.
