The Bills started slow out of the gate in 2007, losing four of their first five games but rallied to win six more games en route to a 7-9 record. To their credit, Buffalo did serve bettors well by posting a 9-6-1 ATS record which included a run of five paydays in a row from the end of September to the start of November. The addition of big WR James Hardy through the draft gives the Bills an end zone threat and opens the running lanes more for RB Marshawn Lynch. Meanwhile, Trent Edwards figures to get the nod over J.P. Losman for starting QB honors as both look for breakout seasons. Last season Edwards threw for 1,630 yards, seven touchdowns and eight interceptions while going 5-4 as a starter. Total bettors should note that the Bills scored only 20 offensive touchdowns last season, a record low for a 16-game schedule. Defensively the Bills ranked 18th in the league in 2007, allowing 22.1 points per game. They fared poorly against the run and pass, ranking 25th and 29th respectively. Luckily the team kept themselves in games by generating 30 turnovers. In the offseason they added defensive tackle Marcus Stroud, linebacker Kawika Mitchell and drafted cornerback Leodis McKelvin to help shore up the rush defense. If they can improve on both sides of the ball this year they have a great chance of sneaking into the NFL playoffs as a wild card. Considering how young and talented the defense is, they might be worth a look to play under the total more often than not.
