The Browns made numerous moves in the offseason to upgrade a roster that posted a 10-6 record last year (12-4 ATS), yet missed a playoff spot. The first priority was re-signing QB Derek Anderson, which leaves Brady Quinn's status in doubt for the time being. This is a good move because it gives the Browns another year to see if Anderson is the real deal and they can go to Quinn if needed. Next they signed WR Donte Stallworth to add to an already potent offense (9-6-1 ATS in 2007). Cleveland also signed tackles Shaun Rogers and Corey Williams to hopefully improve a questionable defense. Head coach Romeo Crennel's contract was extended, making backers pretty happy about the future of their team. Cleveland really did nothing in the draft, as they sent their first three draft picks elsewhere via trades. It all adds up to having 19 starters returning this year, including 11 on offense and eight on defense. With greater expectations in 2008, now they have to prove last year's turnaround was not a fluke. The league must think the Browns are for real, giving them five prime-time games, which is unheard of for a team that did not make the playoffs. The added exposure could certainly play well with sportsbooks and bettors. The Browns seem to be everyone's consensus pick to win the AFC North and that could be a lot more clear by the end of September. They start the season off with a home game against Dallas followed by a home game with Pittsburgh and then hit the road for two games against Baltimore and Cincinnati.
