It was a strange season for the defending Super Bowl champs in 2007. On the plus side, they went 13-3 (9-7 ATS) in the regular season despite a ton of key injuries and managed to finish third in total defense and fifth in offense. The negative side for backers of course was the first-round playoff exit loss at home to the Chargers as favorites. The Colts had a quiet offseason, without a first-round draft pick, and little player movement. They did add RB Mike Hart who is a good pick for this team because he can catch and run with power. That leaves the 2008 Colts looking about the same as they were, which is good for Indy and bad for the rest of the AFC South. The only real difference is they move into their new home, Lucas Oil Stadium. The offense is still loaded with QB Peyton Manning leading the charge. Last season he threw for 4,040 yards, 31 TDs and 14 picks despite playing most of the year without injured WR Marvin Harrison. The Colts dropped to sixth in passing last fall after being near the top in previous seasons. Indy is 29-6 SU and 19-15 ATS at home over the last four years so it will be interesting to see how the numbers go as they move into the new stadium. The Colts are loaded and will be one of the top teams in the AFC with a deadly offense, fast defense and home-field edge. Barring any serious injury to the reigning defensive MVP Bob Sanders, the Colts should repeat as AFC South Champions once again.
