In 2007 the Jaguars showed they are very close to being one of the elite teams in the NFL, but they know they are not going anywhere unless they beat the Colts. Indy has defeated them in nine of twelve meetings since 2002, including twice last season (1-1 ATS). Jacksonville took a huge step last year posting an 11-5 record SU/ATS and by winning their first playoff game since 1999, beating the Steelers in Pittsburgh. In 2008 the Jags are back, having one of the best 1-2 running back punches in the NFL with Fred Taylor and Maurice Jones-Drew. The key for the Jags is the emergence of QB David Garrard who avoided turnovers and threw for 2,509 yards last season. He should be even better this year in his second year as the starter, especially since Jacksonville dished out \$30 million for WR Jerry Porter, who is being penciled in as the No. 1 receiver. The Jaguars have always had the reputation as an all-defensive club under head coach Jack Del Rio. Times are changing after offensive coordinator Dirk Koetter came aboard last season. The Jags finished seventh in total offense averaging 24 PPG, giving the Jags an 11-4-1 O/U record. Totals bettors should note that Jacksonville has played over the total in 30 of their last 48 regular-season games. The Jags have been patient throughout the years waiting for their chance. Expectations are high after winning their first playoff game since 1999 but the schedule now looks tougher, with road games at Chicago, Cincy, Baltimore, Denver and Indy.
