The 2007 version of the Chiefs looked old and tired despite a few new additions. The club posted a 4-12 record (8-7-1 ATS) leaving a lot of room for improvement. This year's Chief squad will look vastly different thanks to moves to add speed and youth. Last season the Chiefs were horrendous on offense as they juggled quarterbacks and played without star RB Larry Johnson when he went down midway through the season. The offense generated just 14.1 points per game (second worst in the league) and 78 yards rushing per game (last in the NFL). The only bright spots were Tony Gonzalez (99 receptions, 5 TDs) and rookie wideout Dwayne Bowe (70 receptions, 5 TDs). This year the Chiefs plan to move tackle Damion McIntosh to the right side and start first-round draft pick Branden Albert at left tackle. QB Brodie Croyle should have a little more time in the pocket this season, giving the coaching staff a chance to see what kind of player they truly have. Johnson is also expected to return healthy which is vital for backers, since last year the Chiefs were 4-4 with Johnson in the lineup and 0-8 without his services. On defense K.C. was much improved despite a 28th-ranked rush defense. They held opponents to 20.9 points per game, and they allowed just 188.5 yards per game through the air. DE Jared Allen was traded and will be missed, but picking LSU's Glenn Dorsey in the draft will certainly help. Dorsey, CB Brandon Flowers, and linebacker Demorrio Williams will give them good depth on the defensive side of the ball.
