The New York Jets under new coach Eric Mangini, surprised everyone in 2006 by going 10-6 (11-5 ATS) and earning a wild card berth. In 2007, they surprised backers again by forgetting how to play football at a professional level. By any standard, last year's 4-12 mark (6-9-1 ATS) was a disaster and the team had to do some regrouping in the offseason. The Jets lacked an offensive identity in 2007 and their stats reflected it. Totalling 16.8 PPG and an average of 188.5 yards per game through the air was not good enough. Mangini benched QB Chad Pennington eight games into the season (one cover) in favor of Kellen Clemens. The results were only slightly better but at least for bettors the Jets notched five paydays to end the year. Due to last season's poor production the club made a concerted effort to upgrade the offense during the offseason. They brought in guards Alan Faneca and Damien Woody as well as veteran fullback Tony Richardson. They also added possible competition to the quarterback position by drafting Eric Ainge out of Tennessee. On the other side of the ball, the Jets were not terrible in 2007, but they did not scare opposing offenses either. They allowed 22.2 PPG and they gave up an average of 134.8 yards per game rushing. To address this the Jets brought in DE/LB Calvin Pace from Arizona and drafted DE Vernon Gholston with their first pick in the draft. The Jets are retooling in 2008 and have a great many holes to try and fill before thinking about the postseason.
