The good news for the Raiders in 2007 was they doubled their win total. The bad news is they only won four games (4-12 SU, 6-10 ATS). This is a team in serious rebuilding mode with a coach, Lane Kiffin, who is the youngest in the league. Last season Oakland did little right on offense aside from rushing the ball well. The team had a quarterback carousel with number one overall pick JaMarcus Russell hardly seeing action until the final two games of the year (both ATS losses). Russell will most likely be under center from day one this year and coupled with the additions of wideout Javon Walker and Arkansas RB Darren McFadden, the Raiders should have more continuity on offense. At the very least backers are hoping that this year's squad can score more than just 17.7 PPG. On the other side of the ball Oakland allowed 24.9 PPG and gave up 145.9 yards per game on the ground. Only having five draft picks made it hard to load up on defensive players. They did however trade for stud CB D'Angelo Hall and lured S Gibril Wilson from the defending champion Giants. Kiffin is banking on his young players improving rapidly in order to better slow opponents down in 2008. This is a team that on paper should do some damage and at the very least be a good bet for those playing the totals. Last season the Raiders posted an impressive 10-5-1 O/U record including six of their last seven games. Another note for bettors looking for value would be Oakland's poor 6-25 SU/12-19 ATS record on the road over the last four seasons.
