Three of four teams made the playoffs out of the NFC East last season - the Eagles were the lone squad to fail to advance. That's not to say that Philadelphia had a terrible season, as they still managed to end up 8-8 (and 8-8 against-the-spread). However, their 3-5 record at home doomed their postseason chances. The Eagles did get a decent season out of starting quarterback Donovan McNabb (89.9 QB rating, 3324 yards passing, 19 touchdowns and just seven interceptions), they'll be hoping that he can stay healthy this whole year and show some of his old form. Philly's top offensive weapon will continue to be running back Brian Westbrook, who rushed for 1333 yards and seven touchdowns last year (while picking up 771 receiving yards and five scores through the air for good measure). Tight end L.J. Smith struggled to stay healthy in 2007, scoring just one touchdown, but he should be back contributing in 2008. Kevin Curtis was McNabb's go-to receiver last year, with 77 catches for 1110 yards and six touchdowns. The Eagles allowed the fewest points in the NFC East last year, but that didn't stop them from adding a couple more pieces to the unit in the offseason - cornerback Asante Samuel and defensive end Chris Clemons were both signed as free agents. That should make it a little bit tougher to play against, but whether or not it results in them leaping past one or two of their division rivals in the standings remains to be seen. If McNabb can stay off injured reserve they should have a shot at the playoffs.
