In 2007 the Titans continued to evolve as a franchise, coming in with a 10-6 record (8-8 ATS) and qualifying for the playoffs. Tennessee lost 17-6 to San Diego as underdogs in the wild card game, ending their season. Their star QB Vince Young did not progress as expected under center by completing 62% of his passes and throwing just nine TD passes vs. 17 interceptions. Norm Chow was fired, and new offensive coordinator Mike Heimerdinger was brought in with the idea of adding another dimension to the passing attack. It won't help that the Titans failed to add a genuine downfield threat at the wide receiver spot, forcing them to continue living with short passes and running the ball to get by. TE Alge Crumpler is probably the biggest addition at a skill position, and if he stays healthy he should quickly become a prime target for Young. Tennessee took running back Chris Johnson in the first round of the draft with hopes that he and RB LenDale White (1,110 yards) form a powerful combination. On the other side of the ball Tennessee is going to once again be bad news for opposing quarterbacks. Kyle Vanden Bosch is one of the better pass rushers in the league, and if newly reacquired defensive end Jevon Kearse works out, it will help offset the loss of Antwan Odom and Travis LaBoy. Overall the defense is pretty solid, making the big question, 'How far can Young stretch the field?' If he starts to harness his throwing arm in a more productive way, there is a chance for the Titans to pull off some upsets and tally more over plays than the five (5-10-1) they had in 2007.
